## **Directions to Ballington Shoot Lodge**

From London or West Country, leave the A303 at the A36 junction at Wylye and follow signs to A36 Salisbury. The first section of A36 is dual carriageway. After the end of the dual carriageway, the turning is only 200 metres on the LEFT into a wide gateway. There will be signs to Ballington Lodge.

From Salisbury on the A36, after the Steeple Langford by-pass there is a long downhill straight with the The Langfords road joining from the left. The turning is on the RIGHT 350 metres after this junction. If you miss the turning and end up on the dual carriageway, take the small left turn immediately the dual carriageway starts that leads to the Ballington/Yarnbury office complex where you can turn round and try again.

The postcode for the house is BA12 0QF. The Lodge turning from the A36 is opposite the gates to the house. Do not go to the house.
